On February 28, 2013, Hamilton County Deputy Alex Gentry, on routine patrol initiated a traffic stop for speeding in Hamilton County, resulting in the alleged narcotics distribution by Lionel Perez of Brighton, Colorado. Deputy Gentry and Undersheriff Nicholas Krug searched the vehicle and found 25 grams of marijuana in a vacuum sealed bag and 30 tablets of Ecstasy in a bottle.

Perez was arrested and lodged in the Hamilton County Jail on allegations of Unlawful Distribution of Controlled Substances; Possession of a Controlled Substance, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and No Drug Tax Stamp affixed to a Controlled Substance.

On March 1, 2013, Perez appeared before the Hamilton County Court on the above – mentioned charges, bond was set at \$15,000.00 with Perez's next court appearance scheduled for March 20, 2013 at 10:00 am MST.
